Hrushikesh Biswal

We invite you to experience phenomenal works by Hrusikesh Biswal, a young Artist from Orissa, who studied at the Baroda school of Art. His works have been collected by major auction houses like Osians and serious Art aficionados. This is Biswal's first solo show.

There is agony and glory of passion in his works as if the Artist has not just painted, but has gestures of a writer who has exerted his thoughts almost like a caricaturist.

There is a sense of order and repose in Hrusikesh's intricately worked objects. He has delicately worked up drawings that emphasize a solid tangible form. There is a crude explanation of love and relationship which are self contradictory but his pictures yet disclose harmony, sometimes with soft fluffed up surfaces and another time with bright tones. His earlier works may seem more decorative almost distracting, but the artist doesn't seem to be compelled to fill space with spirals, swirls, stippling and phallic and conic shapes; its almost a period in life where repetition of these patterns are just a self inflicted exercise to camouflage.

He uses primary colors and expresses himself with strong lines with no clear cut forms he distorts his figures not with aim of expressing superiority but just an expression of his own stark fact and ugliness.
